## Upper Tone

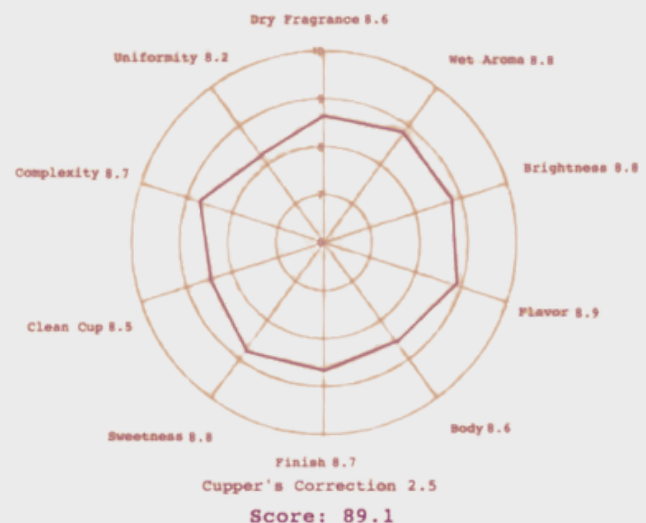
Unmistakable oud with tropical fruit, Spanish Cedar and exotic wood notes.
